Donald Trump

Abortion on Demand

President Trump has pledged "to veto any legislation that weakens current pro-life federal policies and laws or encourages the destruction of innocent human life at any stage."

Pain-Capable

During the 2019 State of the Union address, called on Congress to "pass legislation to prohibit the late-term abortion of children who can feel pain in the mother's womb."

Taxpayer Funding

The Trump Administration issued regulations to ensure Title X funding does not go to facilities that perform or refer for abortions. He has committed to defund abortion providers.



Joe Biden

Joe Biden supports the policy of abortion on demand. He voted for the Harkin Amendment to endorse *Roe v. Wade*, which allows abortion for any reason. Has pledged to "protect the constitutional right to an abortion."

Opposes state laws such as parental notification requirements, mandatory waiting periods, and ultrasound requirements. When asked about restricting abortions after 20 weeks, he said, "I'm not going to interfere with that."

Has promised to restore federal funding for Planned Parenthood. Supports overturning the Hyde Amendment and reversing the Trump Administration's Title X restrictions. Wants to repeal the Mexico City Policy.



Bernie Sanders

Supports abortion on demand. Opposes all efforts to overturn *Roe v. Wade*. Has promised to "appoint federal judges who will uphold women's most fundamental rights." Voted against the Born Alive Protection Act.

Bernie Sanders voted against the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act, legislation to protect unborn children by prohibiting abortion at 20 weeks, when the unborn child can feel pain.

Supports taxpayer funding of abortion and abortion providers. Plans to "repeal the Hyde Amendment and fully fund Planned Parenthood, Title X, and other initiatives that protect the availability of abortion."
